Hidden Landscapes of Stonehenge | British Heritage Stonehenge itself, at the heart of today's World Heritage Site, was built in several stages, beginning as a large circular earthwork bank and ditch circa 3,000 b.c. Remains of cremations within and around pits found here suggest as many as 150 individuals were buried at Stonehenge, making it the largest late Neolithic cemetery in the British Isles.
